The map displays a complex weather pattern over East Asia. A low-pressure system is centered over the Korean Peninsula, with a minimum pressure of approximately 1012 hPa. Another low-pressure area is visible over the Philippine Sea, with a minimum of about 1034 hPa. High-pressure systems are located to the north and east. Wind patterns show strong flows associated with the pressure gradients. Numerous meteorological stations are plotted across the landmasses, providing local observations of temperature, dew point, and wind.
