A graph showing the relationship between Latitude (Y-axis, 0 to 60N) and Nautical Miles (X-axis, 0 to 600). Five curves are plotted, representing distances of 100, 200, 300, 400, and 500 nautical miles. The curves show that for a given distance, the latitude is higher when the distance is measured along a meridian (vertical line) than when it is measured along a parallel (horizontal line).
